ORDER



On November 4, 2019, Magistrate Judge Patricia A. Sullivan issued a Report and Recommendation (“R&R”) (ECF No. 37) recommending that the Court deny the Motion to Dismiss of the defendants, Whisper Yacht Ltd. and S/Y Whisper *in rem*

(ECF No. 18), and deny without prejudice the plaintiff, Robert B. Saltzman's, Cross-Motion for Sanctions (ECF No. 23). After having carefully reviewed the relevant papers, and having heard no objections, the Court ACCEPTS the R&R and adopts the recommendations and reasoning set forth therein.
